Make sure potential buyers' first impression of your home is a good one, let's start with the outside..

Exterior

- Pressure wash driveway & cement paths
- Clean exterior of the home
- Check and repair fence if required
- Clean debris from roof and gutters
- Ensure exterior lights are working properly
- Trim trees, shrubs and/or hedges

Curb Appeal

- Give the mailbox an update
- Remove clutter from the yard
- Mulch around flowerbeds and trees
- Add colorful plants and shrubs
- Create an inviting entry
- Keep the yard freshly mowed

PRE-LISTING CHECKLIST

Clean

- ☐ Clean windows inside and out
- ☐ Clean/dust skirting boards
- ☐ Have carpets professional cleaned
- ☐ Clean Air-conditioner filters and vents
- ☐ Clean or replace worn pillows and rugs
- ☐ Eliminate odors to leave your home smelling fresh and clean
- ☐ Wipe down all surfaces
- ☐ Wipe down all appliances including washer, dryer, fridge, dishwasher, etc.
- ☐ Deep clean all bathrooms and tile grout
- ☐ Dust all shelving and furniture
- ☐ Wash curtains and/or dust blinds
- ☐ Wipe down doors and doorknobs

Declutter

- ☐ Remove magnets from fridge
- ☐ Store, sell, or donate any items or knickknacks you no longer need
- ☐ Organise closets to create empty space
- ☐ Arrange furnishings to make rooms appear larger and more open
- ☐ Put clothing and laundry out of sight
- ☐ Reduce the amount of wall art if distracting
- ☐ Keep electronics and chargers to a minimal
- ☐ Minimize items on counters
- ☐ Move paperwork from counters and home office to out of sight
- ☐ Keep toys in bins
- ☐ Organise pantry
- ☐ Organise garage and create open spaces

Tasks

- ☐ Repair holes or cracks in walls
- ☐ Touchup or repaint walls
- ☐ Check and replace lightbulbs
- ☐ Ensure home appliances and are working properly
- ☐ Fix leaky faucets and loose toilets
- ☐ Ensure windows and doors open, close, and latch properly
- ☐ Remove cobwebs
- ☐ Ensure sinks/tubs/showers drain properly

Room by room CHECKLIST

BEDROOMS

- Clean and organise countertops
- Store personal items in drawers
- Organise closets and create empty space
- Remove family photos and add tasteful pieces of art or décor
- Add lamps if the space is dark to make more inviting
- Keep floors cleaned and vacuumed

BATHROOMS

- Clean and clear all surfaces
- Put up a clean shower curtain
- Make sure all towels and linens match
- Clean any areas with rust or mildew
- Replace caulking on shower/tub
- Keep personal items out of sight
- Remove soap residue and stains

KITCHEN

- Minimise items from countertops
- Remove magnets from fridge
- Clean tile grout
- Scrub and polish the sink
- Keep all mops, brooms, and supplies stowed away
- Empty the garbage before each showing
- Wipe down cabinets and appliances with residue

LIVING ROOM

- Keep coffee and side tables clear of knickknacks
- Make furniture minimal & inviting
- Use pillows and throws to enhance and soften the space
- Have carpets and rugs professionally cleaned
- Box up any personal or unnecessary items
- Store toys and items away

GARAGE

- Clean and sweep out any debris
- Wash or mop floors
- Organise items in bins and store on shelves to keep out of the way
- Repair any wall damage
- Touch up paint where needed

LAUNDRY ROOM

- Put all clothing away
- Organise shelves
- Move clutter and supplies into cabinets
- Wipe down washer and dryer
- Eliminate any unwanted odors
